Maths	<p><b><u>Place value</u></b> The year 1 children will continue to build on their understanding of numbers to 50. They will be able to represent them as tens and ones, compare numbers, order numbers and identify one more and one less.</p> <p><b><u>Multiplication</u></b> Year 1 children will be able to solve questions relating to doubles. They will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s link this understanding with counting coins. Year 2 children will be counting in multiples of 2s, 5s, 10 and 3s. They will use arrays to solve multiplication problems, be able to solve multiplication calculations and link their understanding to money.</p> <p><b><u>Division</u></b> The year 1 children will make equal groups by sharing and grouping.</p>

	The year 2 children will be dividing by 2, 5 and 10. They will also understand their odd and even numbers.
Technology	In our computing lessons we will be learning about algorithms. We will create and debug simple programmes and use logic to predict the behaviour of simple programmes.
Science	In our science lessons we will be learning about different materials. We will be finding out how materials can be changes by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.
The Arts (Art & Design, Music, Drama)	This term we will be exploring and using mechanisms [for example levers, sliders, wheels and axles] to build a form of transport.
Geography	In our Geography lessons we will be able to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will also be learning about weather in hot and cold areas of the world and link it to the Equator and the North and South Poles.
History	We will be learning about Scott of the Antarctic and his race to the South Pole as well as how transport has changed over time.
RE	Our RE lessons will focus on how people celebrate important events in their lives, different religious milestones and certain times are significant or special?
P.E.	Our focus this term will be dance. We will be learning about different kinds of movements. We will also be moving In a variety of different ways and directions.
Modern Foreign Language this term	To use single words, phrases and short sentences to ask and answer the question In Spanish we will be learning how to ask and answer the question 'How are you?' We will also be Listening and responding to rhymes, stories and songs when learning Spanish numbers 1-12 then 13-31.
