



Introduction to our topic

Have you ever wondered about the food that you eat? Where does it come from? What type of food is good for you and what is a balanced diet?

This term Dragonfly class will be learning all about healthy eating. We will follow recipes and have the opportunity to try food we haven't tried before. As well as learning about healthy eating, we will be thinking about why exercise is good for us.

At the end of the term, we will use everything we have learnt about food and healthy eating to plan and throw our own tea party. We will send out party invitations, make party hats and play party games.

Our key learning this term

Personal and social development	Our school value for the term is happiness. We will be learning about food and the importance of eating the right amounts of different types of food. We will also be able describe the importance of exercise and hygiene for humans.

Science	In our science lessons we will be able to identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. We will also be learning about healthy, balanced diets and the importance of exercise and hygiene.
The Arts (Art & Design, Music, Drama)	DT - In DT we will be using a range of equipment and ingredients, to prepare food for a party. We will also be designing and making our own tea party hats. Art- We will make and decorate bowls made from modrock.

Geography	When learning about different types of food, we will find out where the food comes from and identify the different countries on a map of the world. We will also be learning about the similarities and differences between Pensford and an area in Tanzania.
History	For Black history month we will be learning about Ruby Bridges. Ruby Bridges was the first African-American child to go to a white school after desegregation in southern America. We will link it with our own experiences of school.
RE	As a part of our RE lessons, we will be thinking about where we belong. We will be learning about community and will be linking this idea with religion and our families.
Computing	In our IT lessons we will be learning how to use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private; identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other
P.E.	In PE we will be learning about team building and problem solving. We will be focusing on coordination and the children will be working on catching and throwing and applying these skills to some games.
Modern Foreign Language this term	In our Spanish lessons we will become familiar with traditional nursery rhymes in Spanish. By the end of the unit, we will be able to actively participate in six traditional nursery rhymes in Spanish and start to understand and decode more of the spoken Spanish we hear.
