Kingfisher Swimming Lessons – Hengrove Swimming Pool

Kingfisher will be visiting Hengrove Swimming Pool to receive one hour swimming lessons on the mornings of the following dates:

- Thursday 8th September 2022
- Thursday 15th September 2022
- Thursday 22nd September 2022
- Thursday 29th September 2022

On these days, children will need to wear their swimming kit underneath their clothes and bring underwear, goggles and towel to school in a suitable bag.

We will be leaving school at 9.50 am and will return to school in time for lunch so children can choose their school dinner or packed lunch as normal. We have been informed by the coach company that the driver will be wearing a face covering for the journey but children under 11 do not need to wear a face covering on private coach bookings.

The cost of the swimming lessons will be met by the school, but unfortunately we have to ask parents to contribute to the transportation costs. The cost for the 4 trips is **£7.90** per pupil, which we have minimised by booking longer lessons over just four weeks of the term. Your contributions will enable us to use our Sports Premium to provide most of our trips to competitions at minimal or no cost to parents throughout the year. FSM children are not required to pay for the coach.
