Dear Parents and Carers

Re: Sports Day and Fathers Day Lunch next Friday, 17th June

I'm writing to give you some further information about these upcoming events next week. As you know, we are looking forward to inviting fathers or other family members in for lunch, ahead of sports day the same afternoon. Here are the key things that you need to know for both events:

- The Father's Day lunch is **ONLY** for those who have pre-booked and paid on Parent Pay. Please don't just turn up, as we won't have enough space or food!
- The lunch will be in two sittings as follows:
 - **11:45am** arrival for family members of children in Yousafzai and Attenborough Houses
 - **12:20pm** arrival for family members of children in Rashford and Thunberg Houses
- If you are unsure which house your child is in, you can find their initials [here on the houses page of our website](#).
- **Please can your child come to school that day wearing a PLAIN t-shirt** that is the colour associated with their house (**Yousafzai Attenborough Rashford Thunberg**); they should also wear shorts or other suitable PE kit and shoes suitable for running. (If you do not have a suitable T-shirt, don't panic! We have a lot in school that we can lend on the day.)
- Sports day will begin at the field next to the Memorial Hall at 1:30pm. **If you are able to supply and set up a large gazebo that morning, please let us know.** We could do with four gazebos – one for each class.
- Please can parents remain on the opposite side of the track to the children throughout the sports day event.
- **Children will of course need a water bottle and hat, and please apply a long-lasting sunscreen before school.**
- Sports day will likely finish at around 3:30pm. Tennis club will take place as usual, but all other **parents should collect their children from the field even if they are not able to attend sports day.**
