Dear Parents and Carers

I'm pleased to be able to let you know that we have arranged for our usual Friday morning celebration assembly to be held at All Saints Church, Publow this week. This will allow us to make the assembly a 'special' one. As well as us handing out our weekly certificates, the Reverend Denise Calverley has kindly agreed to mark the occasion with a prayer for Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.

Parents and carers are very welcome to join us at the church. The assembly will begin at 9:30am this Friday, 16th September and will last no longer than half an hour.

If your child is in Reception, if possible, please could you drop them off at the church on Friday morning, at 9:20am, instead of bringing them to school? You are welcome to use the church car park. Please note that this applies to Reception children ONLY (not siblings), and is to save the youngest children from having to walk from the school to the church. If your Reception child will be attending breakfast club, or for any other reason this is not possible, please can you let Mrs Rawlinson know, using Class Dojo? Our plan is for Mrs Rawlinson and Mrs Woodhouse to be at the church for 9:20am to meet the children there, and for any children who cannot be dropped at the church to walk down with Dragonfly class.

All other children should be dropped off at school as normal on Friday morning and will walk to the church with their classes. Please remember to send them in with a coat, but there is no need for them to bring a change of footwear for the walk.

After the assembly and prayer, there will be an opportunity for parents, carers and older children to sign a book of condolence and light a candle at the church before returning to school. Reception children and staff will walk back with Dragonfly class, but if Reception parents are also intending to stay for the assembly then they are welcome to drive their own children back if they prefer.

I am very grateful to Rev Calverley for hosting us at the church and I hope that this will support your child in creating memories at this historically significant time.
