Dear Parents and Carers,

2024 Camp for Years 5 and 6

As you will be aware from Mr Barton’s letter of 8th September, I can confirm that Pensford Primary School are booked into Kingswood Residential and Outdoor Activity Centre in North Devon, from **Monday 20th May to Friday 24th May 2024.**

The total cost of the camp stay (including coach hire) will be just over £500 per child.

We will set up a payment scheme where you can pay in instalments as illustrated below. However, because we will be moving from ParentPay to My Child At School for our payments system, the schedule will be set up after half term.

At this stage, you just need to pay a deposit of £50 to secure your child’s place, using ParentPay. (This deposit will not be refundable should you change your mind, but if for any reason we need to cancel the trip then this would be refunded to you.)

The approximate schedule of payments will be as follows:

To be received on ParentPay by:

30 th October (non-refundable deposit)	£50
30 th November 2023	£100
3 rd January 2024	£100
1 st February 2024	£100
1 st March 2024	£100
1 st April 2024	remainder of balance (approx £75*)

*The exact amount will be confirmed by us, by Friday 3rd November once we know how many children are going and therefore the per-person cost of the coach.

So if you would like to book a place for your child, please go to ParentPay to give your consent and to pay the non-refundable deposit of £50.00 by Friday, 20th October 2023. However, if you would like your child to go and cost is the only factor preventing you from signing up, please speak in confidence to Mr Barton to discuss your options. You can contact him on Class Dojo or via the school office.
