Dear Kingfisher parents and carers

I'm writing to let you know about another opportunity that the class will have soon to work with Avon Needs Trees. On Monday, 11th March the Year 5 and Year 6 groups will separately be walking to the Hicks Mead Tree planting site (about a mile away from the school) and helping to plant some more trees now that spring is almost here! Building on the environmental strands of our curriculum, this will give them the chance again to be part of a local initiative that is really ambitious in scale, with the aim of planting 40,000 trees by the end of the project.

On this day, please can the Year 5 children come to school in clothes suitable for being outdoors for the morning, including gloves if they have them. Wellies or walking boots will be needed too. The Year 5s should bring their school uniform to change into when they get back, and a plastic bag for their muddy boots and clothes!

The Year 6s should do the opposite: come to school in uniform but bring outdoor clothes and boots in a bag. They will go to the tree planting site in the afternoon.

All children will have lunch at school as normal.

As this is a local walk in the school day, we don't require permission so you don't need to complete a consent form. Avon Needs Trees may send through an online form later for photo permission, though, and if you have any questions about this please feel free to contact me on Dojo or via the school office.
